Services for October:

October 1, 10 am, "Sometimes people aren't people and sometimes things aren't things" – Lou Farley (spiritual director at Hospice) will provide one guy's experience of insubstantial yet pervasive influences. Zoomers, make sure you have a pocket rock available. Lou will bring rocks for us all.

October 8th, 10 am, "Spirituality and Stories" – Barbara Bogart. When we speak of spiritual experiences, we most often rely on story to express the ineffable. While cognitive science has described how our brains construct narratives, it has yet to capture the sense of mystery that lies at the heart of our felt experiences.

October 15th, 10 am, "The Spirituality of Quitting" – Jeff Lockwood. As of September, we are 25% into our fiscal year—our expenses are 14% of budgeted, income is 23% of anticipated. Expenses will go up with winter heating costs.

The Board approved payment of a student musician, Isabela Araujo, for 2 Sundays a month for the calendar year. The Board voted to reallocate \$1000 from the original budget for a bookkeeper to a music budget under the Program Committee. We will not be hiring a bookkeeper.

The two meeting rooms now have LED's in place of fluorescent fixtures. There are 25-30 "lightly" used fluorescent tubes available for the taking. Any that are not gone by mid-October will be taken to the landfill.
