As of January 10th, we have received 65% of anticipated pledges and are at only 50% of expenses. We are 60% of the way through our fiscal year.

In the interest of transparency and the democratic process, the Board moved to support discussion of four amendments to Article II at this summer's General Assembly. Amendments require the support of no less than 15 congregations to be considered. Our support at this time does not obligate us to vote for any of the four amendments at the actual GA meeting.

The Board completed the questionnaire for the annual Congregational Certification Forms for the UUA which are due February 5th. Robin Chestek subsequently submitted the completed forms on January 18th.
