1. We are 83% through our fiscal year and almost all of our pledges are in! Our expenses are 74% of budged for the year. We are on solid footing financially.

2. The Annual Pledge Drive is in full swing. If you haven't pledged, please put your card in the mail soon. The Pledge Committee is planning on wrapping up the first week in May so the Board can make any necessary adjustments to the proposed budget for next year.

3. The Board is looking for volunteers to attend this year's General Assembly (GA) from June 20<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup>. GA will be entirely online this year. Based on our size, our congregation is allotted two votes for the business part of the meeting. This year the Proposed Article II revision will be coming up for a final vote. 4. Our Annual Meeting is on May 19<sup>th</sup>. We need a quorum of members to transact business, i.e., elect members of the Board, Committee on Ministry, and the Endowment Committee. After a short service from Rev. Kee, we will segue directly into the business portion of the meeting. As this will be Rev. Kee's last Sunday with us, there will be a celebration/send-off honoring Leslie's years of service to us. The agenda will be sent out electronically ten days before the meeting.

5. Committee chairs please submit your annual committee report to David Perry by May 13<sup>th</sup>.

On June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1-3pm there will be a multi-purpose workshop (the 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Death, Dying, What's Next, End of Life Choices' programs) that will include how to complete an advanced directive document, how to write your own obituary and more. There will be breaks and snacks. Everyone is welcome.
